- ABOG certifies OB GYN GENERALIST and 4 OBGYN Subspecialties
 - Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery
 - Gynecologic Oncology
 - Maternal-Fetal Medicine
 - Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility
- ABOG Administers all qualifying and certifying examinations
 - Written board exam = Qualifying exam
 - Oral board exam = Certifying exam
- Physician must be certified in the specialty of OBGYN before becoming board certified in any subspecialty listed above.





- Application service used by medical students and residents to deliver their applications to programs
- Program Managers and Directors can:
 - View and manage applications and documents
 - Correspond with applicants/ send interview invitation
 - Manage interview dates
 - Keep internal scoring and ranking



NRMP – National Residency Matching Program

www.nrmp.org

- allows applicants and program directors to consider each other without pressure
- creates an impartial venue for matching applicants' and program directors' preferences
- fosters fairness in the selection process by ensuring all participants comply with the policies governing the Match
- Residency and Fellowship applicants are "matched" to programs using the rank order lists that are processed by the NRMP matching algorithm.
